

BEHAVIOUR RULES

OF EDUCATION

Not adhering to the following behaviour rules or any of the Institutes rules and regulations (enrolment form/student handbook) may lead to disciplinary procedure.

Behaviour Rules

- \Rightarrow You must treat Institute students, staff and homestay family members with respect

- \Rightarrow You must not smoke or spit on Institute premises
- \Rightarrow You must keep the Institute tidy and clean up areas after use
- \Rightarrow You must complete your set homework before your next class
- \Rightarrow You must tell the Administration Manager if you change your accommodation address and any contact details, such as land and mobile phone numbers, email address, etc
