The test measures the language competency of health practitioners who are seeking registration and the ability to practice in an English speaking context. It is designed to ensure that language competency is assessed in a relevant professional context. Each OET sub-test is scored as one of five grades, from A - E. A is the highest grade, E is the lowest. Most professional registration bodies require a minimum of B in each sub-test.
